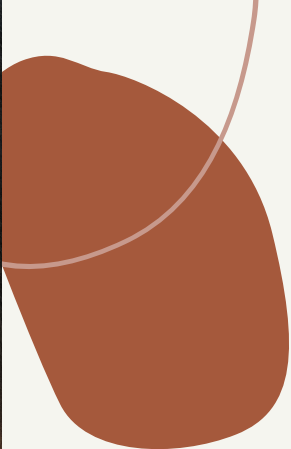


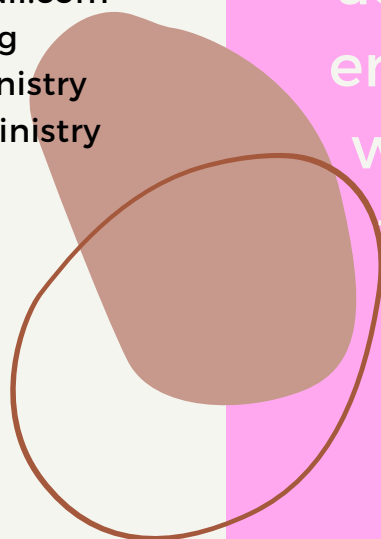

Girl Talk Ministry serves at-risk adolescent girls ages 10-18 in 5th-12th grade. Referrals to the program come from local schools, parents, self-report, and the department of social services.
